1 and told him that we could send him a copy C.O.D. Mr. Hutchins gave me his cell  
2 number and wanted to know exactly when the transcript would be delivered. I told  
3 him that U.P.S. should deliver it the next day by 10:30 a.m.

4 7. I printed out the May 16 Slatkin transcript, which was labeled Volume II,  
5 and delivered it to office support staff to have it sent U.P.S. to Mr. Hutchins.

6 8. On December 5, 2002, at about 8:50 a.m., Mr. Hutchins called me again  
7 to request a copy of Volume III of Slatkin's transcript. That transcript related to an  
8 interview of Mr. Slatkin made on May 26, 2002.

9 9. I printed out a copy of Volume III of the Slatkin transcript and sent it to  
10 Mr. Hutchins for delivery the next day. I sent it C.O.D. by U.P.S.

11 10. Either on December 5 or 6, Mr. Hutchins called me again to request a  
12 copy of Volume I of the Slatkin transcript. I did not see that volume listed in our  
13 database, so I told him that some other court reporting service must have taken it. He  
14 asked me what other court reporting services might have taken it. I told him that I did  
15 not know. I told him to call Kirkland & Ellis to ask what court reporting service took  
16 Volume I.



11. On December 12, 2002, Mr. Hutchins called again and I spoke with him. I put him on hold and asked Nina Kirsch to come into my office and listen as took the call. She did so.
